Workshop 1 is near completion

- PDFs of your Miro Board returned to you as soon as possible (ethics says we can only share these after all consent forms are in).
- In November, some informal regional (time zone) Zoom sessions, to get to know each other better, continue these discussions between Teams, and share emerging insights from analysis.
- Small 'snippets' of data analysis in these newsletters, as that information comes to hand.

Delphi Nominations

We have made great progress gathering your Delphi nominations but still have some way to go to ensure everybody's view is considered; please do pass on that information to your Team Leaders very soon?

Consent forms

Without your consent we cannot share any initial findings and we are very eager to do this! Please get these to your Team Leaders as soon as you can.

What next? And Workshop 2

Workshop 2 will be held during February 2022. Between now and then our Management Team needs to:

- Process your Delphi nominations, recruit the Delphists and collect signed consents from those experts.
- Analyse the Workshop 1 material, from that build Survey 1, and test it through a short trial.
- Send out and collect back Survey 1 from the Delphists.
- Analyse the Survey 1 data. Collate the findings.
- Design Workshop 2.
