#### **Regional Zooms**

Our thanks to everyone for attending your part of the three Regional Zooms held last week and this week. Attendance was wonderful, and peoples' questioning of the analysis of Workshop 2 is helping our Management Team continue to develop the White Paper material. ### The White Paper

This important output (one of our three ILE+SE goals) is developing nicely, and a first draft will be available for your feedback on October 21<sup>st</sup>. The Management Team will use WS2 feedback to finalise the draft for the Roundtables later in November.

### Workshop 3: October 24th to November 4th

Workshop 3 will not be a structured, data-gathering event like the previous two; it will be used by Teams to discuss and provide feedback on the loose draft of the White Paper. That discussion/feedback is critical to ensure all Team members have a say in its development. The Roundtables (where many can't be present) will take that feedback further. The dates above are a narrow window, so we hope as many as possible can contribute.

#### Team preparation for Roundtables

Your representatives at the Roundtables will provide advice about what in the White Paper draft meets your sector and your 'geographical' needs, and where it falls short. The Roundtables will also provide a decision on your behalf about the plans for future research. For these reasons, your representatives to the Roundtables need your input beforehand. Workshop 3 is intended to fulfil that task, but you may need to organise another method as well.

#### Roundtable travels

Planning for the important Roundtables continues. The Eventbrite page for bookings and registrations is expected to be live at the end of next week. Further, all Team Leaders should have now heard from Kelly in regards to booking flights and accommodation for your nominated representative.
