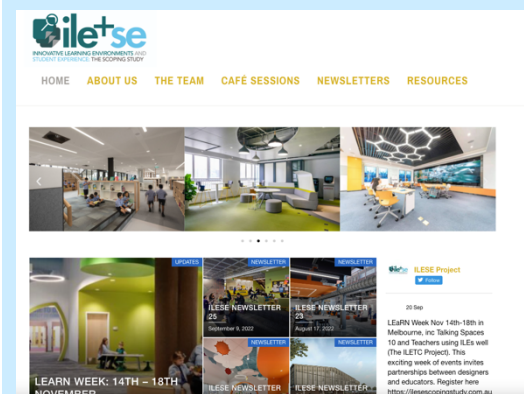
Workshop 2 Analysis (the minor report)
