It has been insightful and encouraging to see the consistent feedback on the draft White Paper and the positive reception of a larger scale project moving forward. Delphi Study progress

The final Delphi panel (academe) has started its verification round. There was 100% consensus between the academic and allied industries panels in terms of the top 5:

- Evaluation of learning environments (first place)
- Design of ILE spaces (second place)
- Hybrid learning environments (third place)
- Academic learning outcomes and assessment (equal fourth place)
- Inclusiveness (equal fourth place)

All three panels (academe, education, allied industries) see evaluation of learning environments, academic learning outcomes and assessment and inclusiveness as being three core priority areas for future research.

We are currently writing the Delphi study report while the academic verification round is underway, and hope to release it soon after this round is completed.
