The Development Phase and Networking

The Development Phase is now underway, with 10 Consortiums beginning work on the creation of a tool to collect wide scale data on the three streams identified by the Scoping Study.

One important aspect of the Scoping Study was the network that was created through the Teams. As we move into the Development Phase our social media presence will be minimal, as the creation of the tools and protocol hold intellectual property belonging to Development Phase Consortiums.

However, we encourage you to continue to use the existing social media accounts to maintain networks. We will continue to share LEARN events and details of the Development Phase that can be made public.

We value the connections that we have made from the Scoping Study, and hope that the established social media channels will allow us to stay connected as we move forward into the bigger ILESE project.

It is time to say goodbye to the ILESE: Scoping Study. We have achieved a lot during the past 18 months. We ran multiple Team Workshops, two large Roundtable events, and two rounds of Regional Zooms with over 250 experts in 20 countries. We ran a Delphi Study with another 37 experts from academia, industry and education. We produced two Workshop Reports, a White Paper and a Delphi Report.

These outcomes are only made possible by the significant input of the Scoping Study Teams. We are really grateful for your time, energy and contribution to this study.
